Commercial and Public (Governmental) Accounts with irrigation are adjusted, upon application, if there is 1,000 square feet or more of irrigated lawn and landscape.

Trailer and Recreational Vehicle (RV) properties are charged a commercial rate, unless validation of 50 percent or less of the total number of units charged a transient tax, then the account is charged the multi-family rate. Commercial = greater than 50 percent of units were charged a transient tax; Multi-family equals less than 50 percent of the units were charged a transient tax.
